## Ladera Verde Chardonnay, Central Valley, Chile (2)

Pure Chardonnay with the merest hint of oak. Aromas of tropical fruit, & well-tuned on the palate. Creamy & smooth texture; a well-balanced & fresh wine.

#### Amanti del Vino Trebbiano, Rubicone, Italy (2)

Fresh & light with good pear & apple fruit with decent length & a creamy texture.

#### Organic Blanco Rioja Bodegas Bagordi, Spain (1)

Ripe citrus notes with floral accents on the nose. A lovely fresh & clean character. Some Sauvignon Blanc makes it crisp & refreshing with good length.

Lean & clean with asparagus & underlying exotic fruits. The extended time on natural lees gives the wine an unexpected texture & nutty charcter.

Fresh aromas of green almonds & white flowers. Peach & greengage notes over flinty minerality & crisp acidity on the palate.

## Soleil des Alpes de Haute Provence Rosé, Southern France (1)

This pale rosé has red berry aromas with hints of summer flowers. Juicy & intense with an attractive balance of soft berry fruit, a touch of melon & refreshing minerality.

## Las Pampas Shiraz Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina (C)

A fruit driven red that has a complex array of flavours. Prunes, dates & figs mixed with hints of spices & a long silky finish.

#### Le Petit Balthazar Merlot, Languedoc, France (B)

A rich ripe nose of blueberries, plums & liquorice. Rounded medium body with a lingering fruity finish.

## Terra Pura Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon, Colchagua, Chile (D)

Intense aromas of red fruits, blueberries & plums with an elegant floral touch, smooth & rounded tannins accompanied by a pleasing touch of oak & a long finish.

## Passitivo Primitivo, Puglia, Italy (E)

Intense ruby red colour with a complex bouquet, reminiscent of cherries, raspberries & redcurrants. Oak ageing adds roasted & spicy aromas with a supple, well-balanced finish.

#### Villa Wolf Pinot Noir, Pfalz, Germany (B)

Soft & fruity to begin but with complex spiciness & an earthy quality. Really lovely minerality on the finish.

## Pure Single Serve Prosecco Extra Dry, Italy (2)

Clean & fresh with soft yet persistent bubbles. Aromas of pear, white flowers, lemon zest & crisp apple on the palate.

Mouthwatering acidity & plenty of fresh fruit, primarily peach, pear & apricot. The bubbles are surprisingly dense providing a fresh sensation in the mouth - a terrific aperitif!
